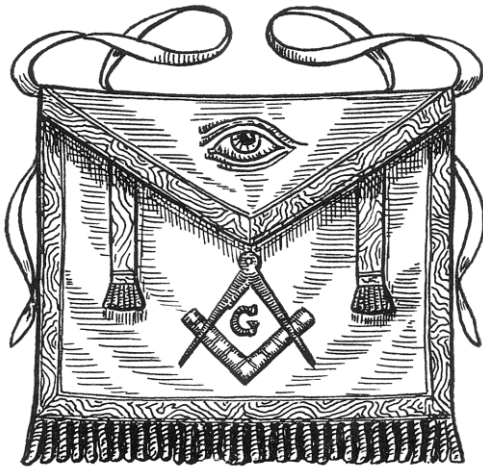

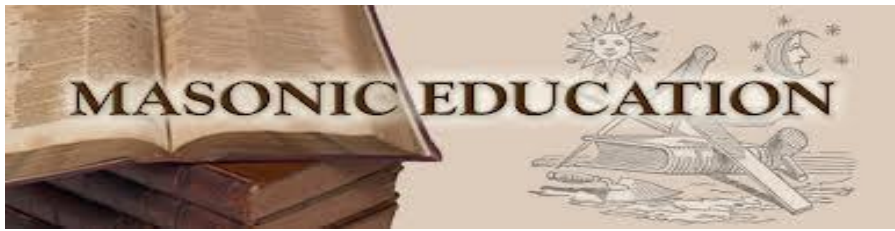
### **Paper Trestle Boards**

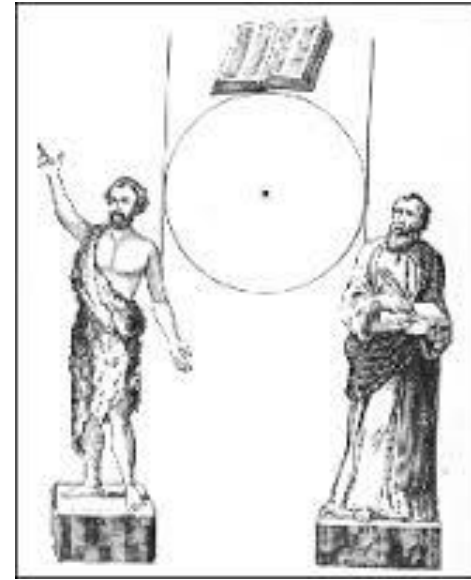
## Who Were the Patron Saints of Masonry?

Masonry, since time immemorial, has dedicated itself to the Holy Saints John. It's important that we not only know who they are, but also who they were and why we dedicate our Blue Lodge craft to their examples.

St. John the Baptist was a cousin of Jesus, and was described as a "voice crying in the wilderness" who's purpose was to "Prepare the way for the Lord". He spread the word of God faithfully and as he did he baptized believers in the river Jordan. He preached and lived righteous living and any deviation was unacceptable.

Because of his devotion to Jesus and his refusal to change his ways, he was imprisoned and eventually beheaded by King Herod. His heroism, fidelity and integrity are echoed in the legends of Jacques DeMolay and Hiram Abif and should still today be an example of conduct regarding our beliefs and devotion to the Masonic teachings.

St. John the Evangelist is believed by the Christian faith to be the Author of the book of John, and many believe that he also wrote the book of Revelations. Regardless, he was an apostle to Jesus, among the most loyal of his disciples, and described as Jesus closest friend. It was with John the Evangelist whom Jesus entrusted the care of his Mother upon his death. He is credited for tying the Masonic Concept of God and Light together in the book of John. Nowhere in the bible, with exception of Genesis, is the concept of light so entwined with the idea of the Devine spirit. He expands on the theme that Gods word and Light are inevitably linked together and ties in Truth as a link in the chain.



The concept of Brotherly Love and Fellowship are explored more thoroughly by John the Evangelist than any other New Testament writer.

Both the Baptist and the Evangelist were considered men of impeccable character. Both were known for their integrity and inflexible fidelity but their manner of teaching the doctrine differed between the two. The Baptist was considered to be dogmatic and rigid in his beliefs. The Evangelist was considered more intellectual and esoteric. It's easy to see why these men have such a prominent place in our history. Although their paths differed in the pursuit of their beliefs, their unwavering devotion and dedication to the doctrine stand as examples for all Masons to exemplify and is why these Patron Saints are considered guides for the way Masons conduct themselves in daily life.
