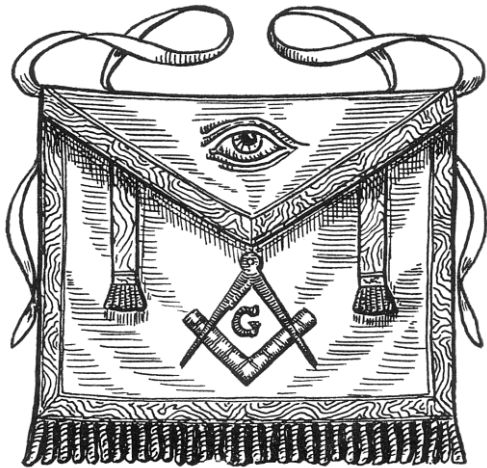

Brethren,

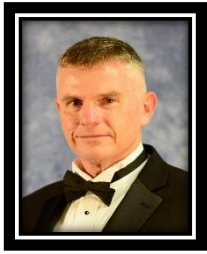
As the year continues down, it is hard to believe that we're in the month of June. It won't be too long and soon we will be going dark for the months of July and August for this Masonic year.
