

The whole weekend was designed to provide veteran and new Secretaries and Treasurers the necessary tools to effectively manage the administrative aspects of the Lodge, as well as many valuable leadership skills essential to communicating with the brethren.

The Grand Secretary updated us on the state of the fraternity and many key issues we face today. Grand Lodge is making it a priority to ensure that members of our great fraternity are being rewarded with a gratifying membership experience by improving prospect applicant education, creating more opportunities for Entered Apprentices and Fellow Crafts to participate in Lodge, and in building a strong candidate coaching program to improve the advancement experience.

The use of technology has been an invaluable tool in implementing new administrative and Masonic educational programs. The iMember database has helped lodges across the state organize and manage membership information with ease. With the development of the business system INTACCT, Treasurers will be able to consolidate financial information into an organized databank. It also acts as an important interface between constituent Lodges and Grand Lodge to help file the required financial reports. Also, Grand Lodge offers an improved candidate education program through the member center at freemason.org. These comprehensive programs offer the candidate essential information to succeed in his Masonic journey.

I would also like to take this time to inform you of the upcoming XIV Word Conference of Regular Masonic Grand Lodges. This worthwhile experience is being held in San Francisco from November 18-21. It will be a once in a lifetime opportunity for you to meet brothers from around the world and have the chance to hear from our Masonic leaders.
